art weighed in the balance and found wanting. Being good has its reward and evil also has its punishment, but it is our place to choose that which we esteem good, or to choose the evil an I pay the consequences.

We, individually, must make the effort to keep that balance which was set up at Creation, as our goal. Many are in confusion today as to what is truth and what is error, and mostly because they desire, not truth but rather someone to agree with them. The greatest philosophers today, who make any effort to tell you truth, generally use a lot of quotations from other authors, which do not always prove their point, but does show that they want one to believe that the other great men believe with them also, and take this as a proof that they were right.

To illustrate the point, I want to tell of a little incident in my life

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which has left a permanent impression upon not only myself but those others concerned.

A movement of which I was an affiliate, had reached the point in its development in which there was inevitably that crossroad in which they must choose between what some were trying to force upon them, and not let them use their own choice and reason and development as the criterion of what was the proper action to take.

They were publishing a booklet called "Keep Balanced", concerning the subject, and I was printing the covers, on a small press, running on power from the light citcuit. The large transformer short-circuited and for some purpose I was on the only circuit alive.

Suddenly, every machine and light stopped but mine. The entire press and composing room crews (about 20) came and stood around to discuss why I only was operating out of 200 workers.

At that time I was under suspicion of some because I refused taking sides until it cooled off. One of them suddenly spoke up and said, "Where do you stand, Bro. Little." A picture was being printed on this cover, showing a road, with fcot steps on both sides and in the middle of the road. On one side they were marked fanaticism, and on the other side compromise. Perceiving their hearts in the matter, after a little hesitation, awaiting the inner voice, the answer came, - "If you and another agree upon the question you put yourselves in the middle of

the road, but if one of us thinks the other is not pushing it as they ought we make him a compromiser, and he makes the other a fanatic, but each puts himself in the middle."

No one answered a word, but soon they all walked away. It was a long time before they tried to get me into their petty arguments. I learned my lesson also, and never since that time have I tried to judge another in regards to their beliefs in these small matters of opinion. The Master judged no man, nor accused none except the liar and the hypocrite. All others he considered their motive but expected them to grow in grace and knowledge, expected them to keep in oneness with the Father. gave them the Holy Spirit to be their guide, and only expected them to live in the light. "If they are not against me they are for me." There can be no middle ground in keeping balanced, but it is a matter of growing, a means of adjusting ourselves to the daily trials and temptations of the world. The promise is, "Lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world."

Let us therefore strive daily, to keep the peace with all men, keep balanced to the extent of our knowledge, strive for more truth, then let it become a part of our lives, love the brethren, and patiently wait for the appearing of our Saviour.

How an Infidel Converted a Sinner

While a small lad, I often visited a cousin, who often said he did not believe in a God, but never found fault in anyone becaus they did. He had his reasons, and according to his several statements when understood by an analytical mind was based upon the idea that most professing followers of the Messiah were really not as earnest in their belief as they supposed, and their examples were often not what one expects of His followers.

As a small child I was always interested in things of a religious nature, but especially in Truth, rather than following someone just because they said so and had a good reputation and following, or my confidence The Scriptures meant more to me than any persons ideas.

So, when we were together, we would often talk about the things in the Bible, and once he said to me, "Harlan, when you tell me a thing is so, I can believe it." This made a great impression upon my childish mind, for it meant that he had more confidence in me than in most of his neighbors, and to me it meant that I must be a living example to those about me. If a child example could convince an infidel, how much more so would the example of older, more mature Christians, convince the whole world.

My uncle owned a country store, and in those days they were the only place to get the news, gossip, and discuss items of interest, around the

cracker barrel, and always there was a crowd of idlers sitting around.

One day a close neighbor, and a prominent church member, was arguing about the Bible and apparently talking too much, and as usual with some persons, it was to cover up a hidden weakness, and in his case was a guilty conscience. This cousin, then quite a young man, was listening intently, and finally being convinced of the hypocrisy of this man, suddenly exclaimed, "Hod", if I believed as you say you do, I would not dare to wait one minute, to make myself right with this God you tell about. I would get down upon my knees right now, here, and confess my sins, not only to that God, but to my neighbors."

Needless to say, this infidels real honesty made so much an impression upon "Hod", that the very next Sunday at his church, he got up and confessed that he had been cheating his neighbors, and other things, making a clean break with his past, and made restitution to all he had wronged, as far as he could. How much easier it would be if all could see and do as they knew to be right and each one try to be an example to those around about them. How much easier to be honest with our Creator and fellowmen, and with ourselves. We may kid ourselves along for a time, we can fool others for a longer time, but we are never fooling our Maker and Saviour any time.

Likewise, our Sunday-keeping brethren might also, if as earnest about their Sunday keeping as they would others believe, might, instead

of trying to make Sunday laws to force others their way, be an example, close their own businesses, refrain from buying on Sunday (including gas for those trips) so they would have to close anyway, and do no unnecessary work, but keep the day as unto their God, they might be more convincing to unbelievers, and their churches filled, instead of trying to have Unconstitutional laws and threatening fines and imprisonment to those who exercise their Constitutional freedoms. Then let others have the same freedom they want for themselves.

An example means more to others than all the words we can use.

The Flushing Remonstrance

We all know about the Religious Freedom postage stamp which was recently issued by the U. S. government, and have used these threecent stamps on our letters. We are glad to have the attention of all called to the liberty which we all hold so dear.

You may have noticed on this stamp the words, "The Flushing Remonstrance," and wondered, as I did, what that referred to, since most history books do not mention it.

I found that this refers to a document that was signed on Dec. 27, 1657, in Flushing, Long Island, New York. This town was founded in 1645 in the Dutch colony of New Netherlands. Since the Dutch West India Company had a little difficulty finding enough people who wanted to leave Europe and come to this settlement, they found that by promising religious liberty they could accomplish what in many cases they could not by other inducements.

The charter granted to the town of Flushing guaranteed the people liberty of conscience "according to the custom and manner of Holland, without molestation or disturbance from any magistrates, or any other eccleiastical minister that may pretend jurisdiction over them."

All went well until Peter Stuyvesant became governor. As early as 1652 he began interfering with freedom of worship in various ways.

A few years later, Quakers began arriving in the New World. We all know how they were persecuted,

and yet they kept coming. The town of Flushing, which was especially religious-freedom conscious, offered them refuge. Peter Stuyvesant, perhaps irked by the fact that these people would not doff their hats in the presence of the governor, and being a strict Calvinist, was very angry when he learned they were being offered shelter in the colony. He immediately issued a proclamation and ordered it posted in every town. It declared that any ship that

The settlers in Flushing were very indignant when they read this edict. They felt it was their duty to do good to all men, and were not willing to refuse entrance to their town or their houses because his religious belief might be different from theirs. They could not submit to the governor's demands.

On the night of December 27,1657 the leading men of the town gathered in the house of Michael Milner, and wrote up a remonstrance. That was the customary method of protest used among the Dutch of that period when they had a grievance.

Among other things they declared: "Our desire is not to offend one of His little ones, in whatsoever form, name, or title he appears in, whether Presbyterian, Independent, Baptist, or Quaker, but shall be glad to see anything of God in any of them, desireing to doe unto all men as we desire all men should doe unto us, which is the true law both of Church and State."

This Remonstrance was delivered to Governor Stuyvesant in New Amsterdam, but it appeared to be a failure, for the man who delivered it, Tobias Feake, was thrown into jail, and the Remonstrance was filed away in the archives.

The real hero of religious freedom in Flushing came into prominence

five years later. In 1662 John Bowne defied the governor's edict by allowing the Quakers to hold services in his home. Magistrates of the nearby town of Jamaica complained to Stuyvesant.

He sent soldiers to arrest M. Bowne and take him to New Amsterdam where he was tried, fined 150 florins aad warned to "abstain himself in the future from all such meetings" or face double the fine and banishment. But he refused to pay the fine or discontinue the services. He was then taken away from his wife and two children and put in a dungeon on a diet of bread and water. He was later deported, and his fine new house (which is now a museum) was seized.

In Holland he presented his case before the West India Company. showing them a copy of the charter of Flushing, which guaranteed religious freedom. The directors of the company tried to get Mr. Bowne to compromise, but he would not, and they finally sent him back to New Amsterdam, and sent ahead of him a letter to Stuyvesent, saying, "In all events, peoples conscience should not be forced by anyone but remain free in itself, as long as he is modest, and does not disturb others or oppose the government. You will therefore regulate yourself accordingly."

The governor thereafter treated Bowne with respect, and never again interfered with religious liberty in Flushing. Thus the principles outlined in the Flushing Remonstrance, and held to so courageously

Separation: not Iraternalization. important in Sabbath Promotion

Jesus said in giving the Great Commission to His Disciples in Mark 16: 15, "Go ye into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature," and every Sabbath-keeper considers the Sabbath truth an important part of the Gospel message. It is certainly the desire of all true Sabbath-keepers to teach this precious truth to others and to encourage the observance of the Bible Sabbath everywhere. It is therefore the concern of every obedient follower how this truth can best be promoted. The question has arisen as to whether promotion can be accomplished better by fraternizing with those who differ or by separation from them. Let us seek our answer to this question by turning to the Word of God.

When God first called His people Israel and gave them the Holy Commandments which include the observance of the seventh day Sabbath, He told them, "Thou art an HOLY (Heb. godesh, separate) people unto the Lord, thy God. The Lord thy God hath chosen thee to be a SPECIAL PEO-PLE unto Himself above all people that are upon the face of the earth." (Deut. 7:6.) He gave them the holy Sabbath as a special sign, "between me and them that they might know that I am the Lord that SANCTIFY (Heb. qodesh, separate) them." (Ezek. 20:12.) They were strictly forbidden to fraternalize with other people on the grounds that "They will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other Gods" (Deut. 7:4. The Creator who originated human nature knew that fraternization with error would undermine the truth, so He wisely commended separation from the very beginning to His chosen people.

God's servants tried to preserve this separation all down through the history of Israel. The prophet, Isaiah, once cried out, "To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them." (Isa. 8:20.) Sabbathkeepers still universally apply this Scripture to the Holy Commandments of the Decalogue. Therefore, as we understand it, those who walk in disobelience to these commandments, even one of them, have no light in them and walk in darkness. Israel of old was commanded strictly to keep themselves separate from the disobedient children of darkness; are we so much superior than ancient Israel that we can fellowship and fraternize with darkness without injury? In the New Testament we read,, "What commu :ion hath light with darkness." (2 Cor. 6:14.) How can the children of light fraternize with the children of dark-

Now those of us who walk according to the rule of the New Creation in Christ Jesus are known as the Israel of God. (Gal. 6:16.) We are as truly God's Israel as the descendants of Jacob Isaac, and Abraham were under the Old Covenant. "If ye be Christ's then are ye Abraham's seed and heirs according to the premise," (Gal. 3:29.)

Peter here recognizes our great commision to "Show forth" or go into all the world and reach the Gospel to every creature, but in order to that end he tells us we are a peculiar people chosen and called out of darkness and separated, set apart. By the children of darkness we may be looked down upon as peculiar fanatics, and misunderstood; but that was exactly the case with our Master. Did he try to gain influence and prestige by associating himself with the Sanhedrin, or through fraternities of the Scribes, the Pharisees or the Essenes? Of course not! But every Sabbath-keeper agrees that the true Gospel spread faster and flourished more in the days when the Christians were looked down upon and separated as a peculiar people than it did from the time of Constantine when Christianity began to fraternize with error.

We might case a lot of persecution, gain more popularity, and inspire confidence in ourselves if we try to show people we are not so greatly different from them by fraternizing them in their life of disobedience to God's laws; but we will inspire far more confidence within them in God and His laws if we show the disobedient that WE ARE DIFFERENT!

The Apostle Paul wrote to Timothy, 2 Tim. 2:20-21, "In a great house (such as Christendom) there

are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honor and some to dishonor. If a man therefore PURGE HIMSELF (cleanse out) from these (vessels of dishonor) he shall be a vessel unto honor SANCTIFIED (separate -set apart) and meet for the Master's use." The Apostle Paul bas no doubt been responsible for the spread and promotion of the Gospel as much and possibly more than any other human being. Did this old Gospel Warrior here tell his son, Timothy, to get into the Eov Scouts. The United Drys, the P.T.A. and the Ministerial Alliance and every other Civic or religious organization he could enter in his community? On the contrary, his advice was to "purge himself" out of every vessel that did not honor the Creator if he wished to be useful to the Master.

One large Sabbath-keeping organization has proved beyond successful contradiction that separation is far superior to fraternization in the matter of schools. Although activity in the local P.T.A. might bring an occasional break in favor of the Sabbath-keeper in the Public School, how much more effective it is for Sabbath-keepers to have THEIR OWN SEPARATE SCHOOLS! It would well behoove other Sabbath-keeping organizations to follow this example.

The Apostle Paul warned the Corinthians, "Be ye NOT unequally yoked together with unbelievers, for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrightousness? Or what communion hath light wth darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? Or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? And what agreement hath

the Temple of God with idols? For ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, "I will dwell in them and walk in them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them and BE YE SEPARATE, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing and I will receive you." (2 Cor. 6:14-17.

When one becomes a member of civic or religious organizations which include members who do not respect and keep ALL of God's Holy Law he immediately vokes himself together unequally with unbelievers; he joins with the forces of unrightousness; he fellowships with the children of Darkness. They speak not according to the law and the testimony and therefore there is no light in them according to the prophet, Isaiah. Nothing can be accomplished for the spread of truth by such alliances; on the other hand our Master says, "Come out from among them and BE YE SEPAR-ATE" if we wish to be meet for His

We can no more win people to the truth by fraternizing with them in their error than a sound apple can redeem a bushel of rots to soundness by being placed among them. Everyone knows that a good apple will soon lose its soundness when placed in close association with rots; likewise God knows that His people cannot keep their purity and at the same time fraternize with the disobedient. Therefore His call has always been and still is a call of separation. God's ministers are separators, not mixers.

Now there is a place for fraternalization in the promotion of the Sabbath Truth. "If we walk in the light,

Kosher Store Ruling Asked

Boston (AP) May 3, 1958 A Kosher meat market has asked a three-judge tribunal to decide wheth er it has a right to open Sundays,

Crown Kosher Super Market, Inc. of Springfield seeks a declaratory judgment against Springfield Police Chief Ralph Gallagher.

The suit alleges the Sunday law is unconstitutional in that it discriminates against a particular religious faith. The complaint states that the kosher markets are closed on Saturdays, the Jewish Sabbath, but must close Sundays by state law.

The manager of the Crown market was arrested for doing business Sundays, the complaint states.

- 3. Christ devoted His life primarily to the exaltation of the Ten Commandments (Matt. 5:19-20; 7:21, etc.) warning his followers against accepting the traditions of men (Mark 7:7-9).
- 4. The Apostle Paul records that the Law of God was his only guide to the knowledge of sin (Rom. 3:20; 7:7) also cautioning against following the deceitful traditions of men (Col. 2:8).
- 5. Sunday-observance rejects the Law of God and accepts a pagan-born rest day, and is, therefore, a double violation of the teachings and the customs of both the Messiah and of the Great Apostle.
- 6. Sabbath-observance, already firmly established in the early New Testament Churches, continued (according to the Church Historian, Socrates) in all the Churches, except in Rome and Alexandria, until the close of the 5th century after which mass persecution of Sabbath-keepers placed them in the minority.

Gospel-Age Sabbatarianism

"There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God. For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his. Let us labor therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief." (Hebrews 4:9-11)

If the seventh-day Sabbath is to be observed by the saints during this Gospel Age, why was there no specific command given for such observance? This is a question often asked by those who do not believe it is necessary to keep the Sabbath now.

The question may be answered by the fact that the Moral Law, of which the Sabbath is a part (Ex. 20: 1-17), is eternal: hence all believers have been and are obligated to obey it in all ages (Deut. 7:9; Psa. 111: 7-10; Matt. 5:17-20; Rom. 3:31; 7:1; 1 John 5:2-3; James 2:8-12; Rev. 14: 12; 22:14).

In addition we have the example of our own Savior keeping the Sabbath, and meeting with others on that day for worship (Luke 4:16-19) And what He thot of Sabbathkeeping, following His ascension into heaven, is revealed in His final instructions and admonition to His disciples as follows: "But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter neither on the sabbath day." (Matt. 24 20)

Besides we have the example of the Early Church meeting on the Sabbath for services, and the Gentile converts also embracing the Sabbath and meeting with the Jewish converts on that day (Acts 13:42-46; 15:19-21; 16:12, 13; 17:1,2; 18:4-4, 11). Sacred history also shows that the Christian church observed the seventh-day Sabbath for nany many years before Sunday observance took its place.

Now as the question of a direct or specific command in the New Scriptures regarding the Sabbath institution, see Hebrews Four, as given above. There are actually three types of rest treated in this chapter: first, Gospel rest (or rest from the burdens of sin, verses 2 & 3); second, millennial rest (or the rest in the Millennium when Satan will be bound, verses 7 and 8; Psa. 95:7-11); a physical rest on the seventh day of the week (verses 4, 9, 10).

The Creator rested on the seventh day of the week from all His works and when we enter into His rest, we shall cease from our own works as He did from His- on the se venth day. Furthermore, the Hebrew writer stated that "There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God" (Heb. 4:9.)

Some of the definitions given by Webster for "remain" are: endure; to be left for future consideration or use; to continue in the same given state. There remaineth, or continueth, therefore, the "keeping of a sabbath" (marginal reading) for the people of God. For what people? For the people of God!

This should be clear enough for every lover of truth, to cause him to realize that Sabbath observance is for all of the believers. It will be of special interest, we believe, for the reader to learn that Dr. George Lamsa in his "The Modern New Testament," from the Aramic, rendered Hebrews 4:9 thusly: "It is therefore the duty of the people of God to keep the Sabbath." A specific command; is it not?

If anyone should question the reliability of the Aramic manuscripts, rest assured that research has revealed that the oldest manuscripts of the New Testament writings that have so far been found, are in Aramic (Semitic languages and dialects among the Syriac, Biblical and Palestinian Aramic, and Samaritan are most important).
